Your Excellency,

Writing in my personal capacity, I would like to ask you to kindly convey to the senior command of the Slovenian Police my sincere gratitude for and appreciation of assistance I received from a police officer on duty at the main border crossing point near the town of Brezice on the 21st of July 2007.

My wife and myself had an uneasy time on that day, driving from Ljubljana to Zagreb and further on to Sarajevo in the conditions of extremely hot weather, when our car stopped dead on the highway - fortunately in the immediate vicinity of the Slovenian immigration and customs posts.

At about 18.30 we turned for help to the border police station (PMP Obrezie) where one of officers on duty, namely officer **Ruedl, Bostijan**, behaving and acting very attentively and efficiently, quickly arranged for a timely technical assistance (evacuation and repairs) despite after-business hours on a Friday evening.

Again, Your Excellency, I would much appreciate if this commendable example of a police officer's good work, maybe even outside his/her immediate duties, is brought to the attention of the Slovenian Police commanders.
