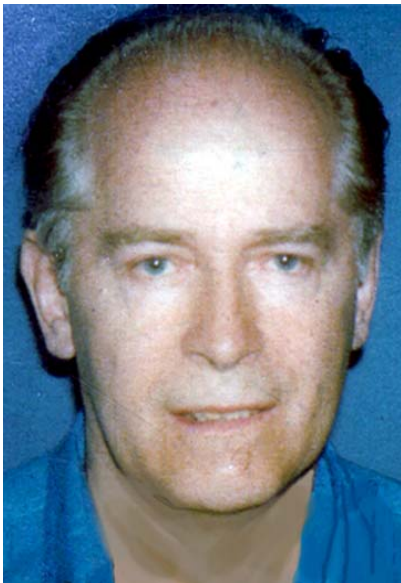

**Wanted by: The United States**

**Wanted for: Extortion, membership of a racketeer-influenced corrupt organisation and money laundering**

**Case details:** James BULGER is wanted for his alleged involvement in the murder of 19 people between the early 1970s and mid 1980s whilst he was the leader of an organised crime group. BULGER has been on the run from authorities since 1995 and is believed to be with his longtime girlfriend, Catherine Elizabeth GREIG born 3 April 1951. BULGER is known to have travelled throughout the United States from January 1995 onwards. He also travelled regularly through Europe where he is believed to be hiding. BULGER is an avid reader with an interest in history, particularly World War II and related memorabilia and is known to frequent libraries and historic sites. BULGER may be taking heart medication. He has been known to alter his appearance in the past through the use of disguises. Old photographs show BULGER as having a yellowed front tooth.
