ZAMOLSKIS (POLICE ENHANCED IMAGE)

Case details: ZAMOLSKIS is wanted for his suspected involvement in the murder of two people, and the wounding of three police officers, and the possession of illegal weapons and ammunition.

ZAMOLSKIS is accused of fatally assaulting a person in January 1993. Three months later he allegedly shot and wounded a police officer whilst attempting to steal weapons and ammunition from a shooting range.

In 1994 ZAMOLSKIS and three accomplices were suspected of a second killing, and in April 2001 ZAMOLSKIS was involved in the wounding and robbery of a man in Palanga. Later that same year he is accused of shooting and wounding two police officers who were checking the identity documents of ZAMOLSKIS and two accomplices.

ZAMOLSKIS is known to frequently change his appearance by shaving his head and growing a moustache and beard. Police have developed an enhanced image depicting what ZAMOLSKIS may look like today.

It is believed that ZAMOLSKIS is located somewhere within Europe, however his current location is not known.
