a phone scam in which fraudsters try to trick the victim Vishing (a combination of the words Voice and Phishing) is into transferring money to them. into divulging personal, financial or security information or

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Beware of unsolicited telephone calls.
- Take the caller's number and advise them that you will call them back.
- phone number and contact them directly. In order to validate their identity, look up the organisation's
- Don't validate the caller using the phone number they have given you (this could be a fake or spoofed number)
- Fraudsters can find your basic information online (e.g. social have such details. media). Don't assume a caller is genuine just because they
- Don't share your credit or debit card PIN number or your online banking password. Your bank will never ask for such details.
- Don't transfer money to another account on their request. Your bank will never ask you to do so.
- If you think it's a bogus call, report it to your bank.
