Procedures used in restorative justice

The paper presents different procedures developed on the basis of the restorative justice concept. Since special attention is devoted to mediation as the most important of these procedures, the paper provides a description of the course of the mediation procedure and presents different types of mediation procedures that have been developed in the world. The author then describes possibilities of successfully concluded or, at least on the part of the offender, sincerely attempted mediation under classical procedural and substantive criminal law.

Finally, he makes proposals for the appropriate formulation and implementation of mediation in the Slovene legal system.
