

Editorial

Dear readers,

In front of you, please find the fourth issue of the *Journal of Criminal Investigation and Criminology* for 2022, published in English. The Journal has been published for seven decades and maintains its reputation as the most important scientific and professional publication on criminal investigation and criminology in Slovenia.

This year is special for Slovenian criminology and criminal justice studies, with three scholars from Slovenia receiving continental and international recognition for their research in the field of criminology, penology and comparative criminology. Rok Hacin, Assistant Professor of Criminology at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, University of Maribor, received the *European Society of Criminology (ESC): Young Scholar Award* (2020) for his article on legitimacy in Slovenian prisons based on his doctoral research published in the *European Journal of Crime, Criminal Law and Criminal Justice*. This award was presented to him at the ESC conference in Málaga, Spain, in September 2022, after a two-year delay due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Another prestigious award recipient from the European Society of Criminology is Aleš Zavrnik, full Professor and Director of the Institute of Criminology at the Faculty of Law in Ljubljana. Professor Zavrnik received the *European Journal of Criminology: Best Article of the Year Award* for his article *Algorithmic justice: Algorithms and big data in criminal justice settings*, published in the *European Journal of Criminology* in 2021. The third Slovenian criminologist who received international recognition in 2022 is Gorazd Meško, full Professor of Criminology and Head of the Institute of Criminal Justice and Security at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, University of Maribor. Professor Meško received the *Freda Adler Award* from the Division of International Criminology of the American Society of Criminology. The main reason for Professor Meško receiving this award is his numerous and ongoing contributions to the development of international and comparative criminological research. He has conducted numerous international research projects with many international partners and published research articles, book chapters and edited books published by international publishers. Congratulations to all three criminologists who are also members of the *Journal of Criminal Investigation and Criminology* editorial team.

The fourth issue of the *Journal of Criminal Investigation and Criminology* consists of four scientific articles. The first, on prisoners' perception of treatment, is written by Aco C. Bobić, Predrag D. Pavličević, and Rok Hacin. The second article presents perspectives on domestic violence from professional

pred vami je četrta številka Revije za kriminalistiko in kriminologijo v letu 2022, izdana v angleškem jeziku. Revija izhaja že sedem desetletij in ohranja sloves najpomembnejše znanstvene in strokovne publikacije s področja kriminalistike in kriminologije v Sloveniji.

Letošnje leto je posebno za slovensko kriminologijo in varstvoslovje. Tриje slovenski znanstveniki so bili nagrjeni s kontinentalnimi in mednarodnimi priznanji za svoje raziskave na področju kriminologije, penologije in primerjalne kriminologije. Rok Hacin, docent za kriminologijo na Fakulteti za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru, je prejel nagrado *Young Scholar Award* (2020) Evropskega združenja za kriminologijo (European Society of Criminology – ESC) za članek o legitimnosti v slovenskih zaporih, ki temelji na njegovi doktorski raziskavi, objavljeni v *European Journal of Crime, Criminal Law and Criminal Justice*. Nagrado so mu podelili na konferenci ESC v Málagi v Španiji septembra 2022 z dveletno zamudo zaradi pandemije covid-19. Drugi prejemnik prestižne nagrade Evropskega združenja za kriminologijo je Aleš Zavrnik, redni profesor in direktor Inštituta za kriminologijo pri Pravni fakulteti v Ljubljani. Profesor Zavrnik je prejel nagrado *European Journal of Criminology Best Article of the Year Award* za članek *Algorithmic justice: Algorithms and big data in criminal justice settings*, objavljen v *European Journal of Criminology* leta 2021. Tretji slovenski kriminolog, ki je leta 2022 prejel mednarodno priznanje, je Gorazd Meško, redni profesor za kriminologijo in predstojnik Inštituta za varstvoslovje na Fakulteti za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru. Profesor Meško je prejel nagrado *Freda Adler*, ki jo podeljuje Oddelek za mednarodno kriminologijo Ameriškega združenja za kriminologijo (Division of International Criminology of the American Society of Criminology). Glavni razlog za podelitev nagrade profesorju Mešku je njegov prispevek k razvoju mednarodnih in primerjalnih kriminoloških raziskav. Izvedel je številne mednarodne raziskovalne projekte s številnimi mednarodnimi partnerji ter objavil članke, poglavja v knjigah in uredil knjige, izdane pri mednarodnih založbah. Čestitke vsem trem kriminologom, ki so tudi člani uredništva Revije za kriminalistiko in kriminologijo.

Četrti številko Revije za kriminalistiko in kriminologijo sestavljajo štirje znanstveni članki. Prvi članek o percepciji obravnave zapornikov so napisali Aco C. Bobić, Predrag D. Pavličević in Rok Hacin. Drugi članek predstavlja poglede na nasilje v družini iz poklicnih izkušenj, motivacije in spolnih predsodkov delavk. Članek sta napisala Anita Dremel in

experience, motivation and gender prejudice of female professionals and is written by Anita Dremel and Renato Matić. The third article by Monika Klun, Danijela Frangež, and Aleš Bučar Ručman presents a study on the characteristics and prevalence of adult children's violence against their parents. The final article by Vanja Erčulj and Gorazd Meško presents a study on fear of crime from two perspectives – fear of ordinary and fear of cyber crime. In addition to the articles, a book review by Iza Kokoravec of *Crime and Safety in the Rural: Lessons from Research*, authored by Vania Ceccato and Jonatan Abraham, is included.

I would like to thank all contributors and reviewers for their excellent work and contribution to the Journal's quality. I wish the readers of the *Journal of Criminal Investigation and Criminology* an abundance of pleasure in reading this issue of the Journal and invite scholars to enrich the Journal's future editions with their contributions.
